



Sage 50 2010 – New features.

Sage 50 2010 contains a wealth of improvements including:

New Guides – Sage New guides for month/year end and VAT provide instant assistance for new users or those that carry out these on an infrequent basis.

Improved Video/simulations Guides – These new interactive simulations guide new users or users carrying out an unfamiliar task through 20 plus ‘what should I do first’ and ‘regular tasks’ allowing users to build confidence more easily.

Improved Customer Receipts and Supplier Payments management - This feature allows you to deal far more efficiently with Customers and Suppliers – allowing you to filter, sort add additional information to aid tracking (ex. ref), it also allows the creation of credits directly from invoices and automatic allocation.

New ‘Pay Now’ Button on electronic documents – This allows you to add ‘Pay Now’ buttons to electronic documents (invoices, letters and statements). Which enables your customers to pay you quickly and securely – any payments made can then be automatically downloaded to Sage 50 Accounts, ensuring efficient cash-flow (Note to utilise this you must have a Sage pay account).

New Cash Register/Till takings – New pre-configured screens to help you to record till and cash register takings. These are designed to make the process quick and easy for all users in particular for those involved in retail.

Improved VAT management – Many businesses are required to produce and file an EC sales list – the rules for these are changing in January 2010, to include services. V2010 is ready for this change and the revised pro-formas will be delivered by an auto-update. Ensuring that you keep compliant.

Improved Management of recurring entries – Enhancements mean that it is now much easier to manage and view recurring payments – easily change processing date, easily check payment details, amount or number of payments outstanding. Allowing you to more efficiently plan, reconcile or answer queries.

New File Import and Import templates – This new feature includes the ability to import .xls files, match columns from data sources to Sage 50 Accounts tables, creation saving and reuse of map files. And enables you to more easily import information into Sage 50 Accounts and reduce errors.

New Sage Pay Integration – This new feature allows you to download payment file & transactions automatically recorded within Sage 50 Accounts and allows refunds to be processed back onto a credit card (this does require you to have a Sage Pay account).

Improved reporting Functionality – There is a new report browser allowing you to easily see which reports are run when and set up favourites. Sage 50 Accounts also now supports product barcodes. Enabling you to manage your reports more efficiently.

Improved process management – There are over 40 usability improvements in this area including – ability to suppress Yearend management messaging, improved back up naming, key board access and the ability to open financial and nominal screens at the same-time. Making Sage 50 Accounts easier and faster to use than ever before.
